Tax Season so far: 26 volunteers have completed well over 1,000 federal tax returns in about 6 weeks' time. These volunteers continue to work tirelessly at 8 different locations, making it as easy as possible for people to get to us to have their returns prepared thoroughly and professionally. A lot of people don't realize that we can prepare returns for young and old alike! We want to make sure that no one who is low income OR elderly on a fixed income has to pay to have their returns prepared. These are the people that need to keep their money for more important things!

Our last Quarterly Workshop was presented by Veterans Affairs agent Brian Evans. Brian gave us good information about conditions that affect veterans' claims for benefits and also some things that people don't realize they may qualify for.

Our next Quarterly Workshop is scheduled for April 18th at 10:00 in the Etowah County courthouse. Students from Pathways Academy will be on hand to help seniors learn how to utilize their cell phones and tablets. Call us if you want to attend!

## SUCCESS STORY

Every year the Council on Aging of Etowah County helps people during Medicare Open Enrollment make sure that they have the best Medicare plan for their needs. Plans change every year which means that what has worked for someone before may not be the best plan for the coming year. From October-December, 2018, 7 volunteers along with Council on Aging staff helped 367 clients realize a \$174,730 savings in prescription prices.
