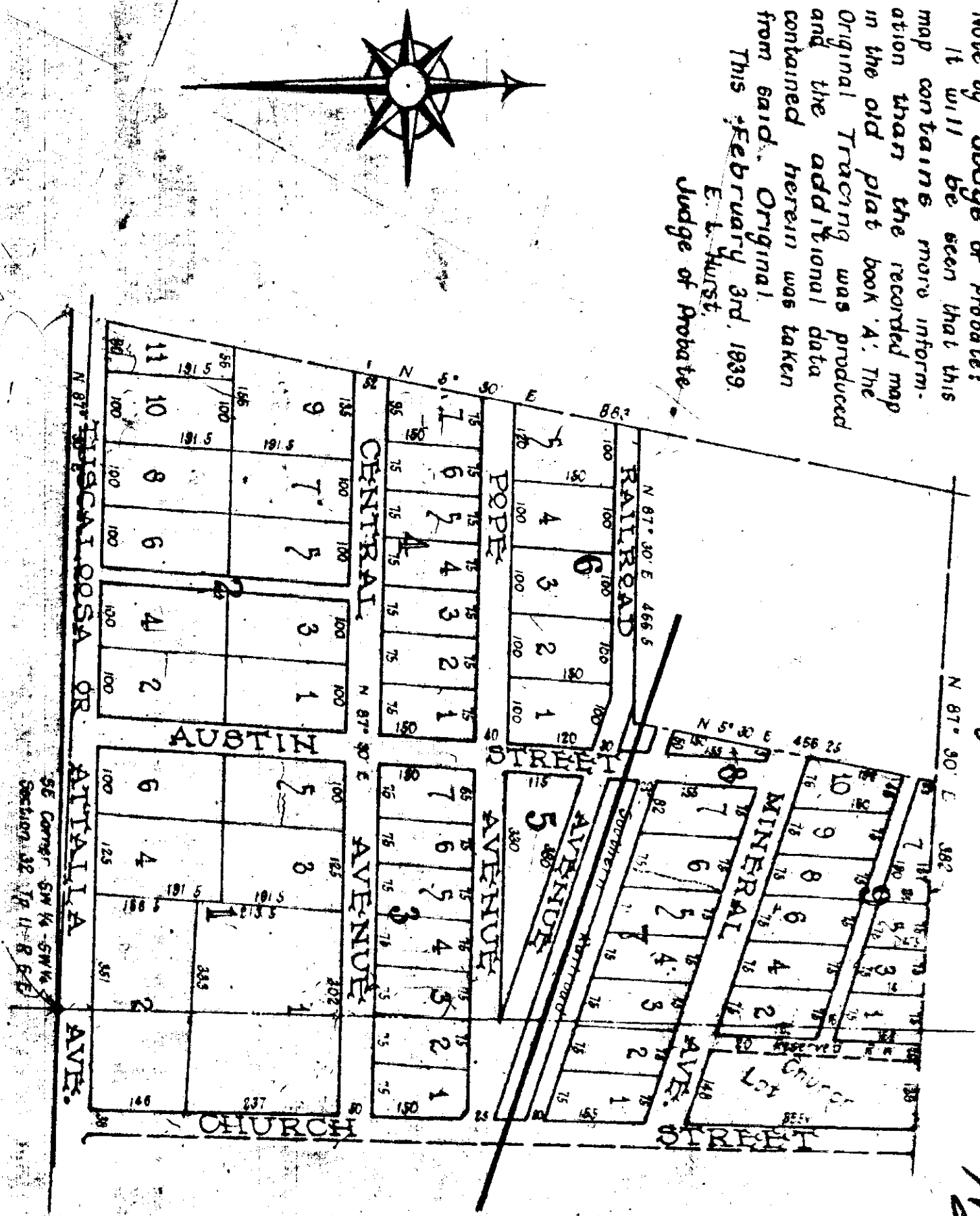


**J. M. PATRICK PLAT**
