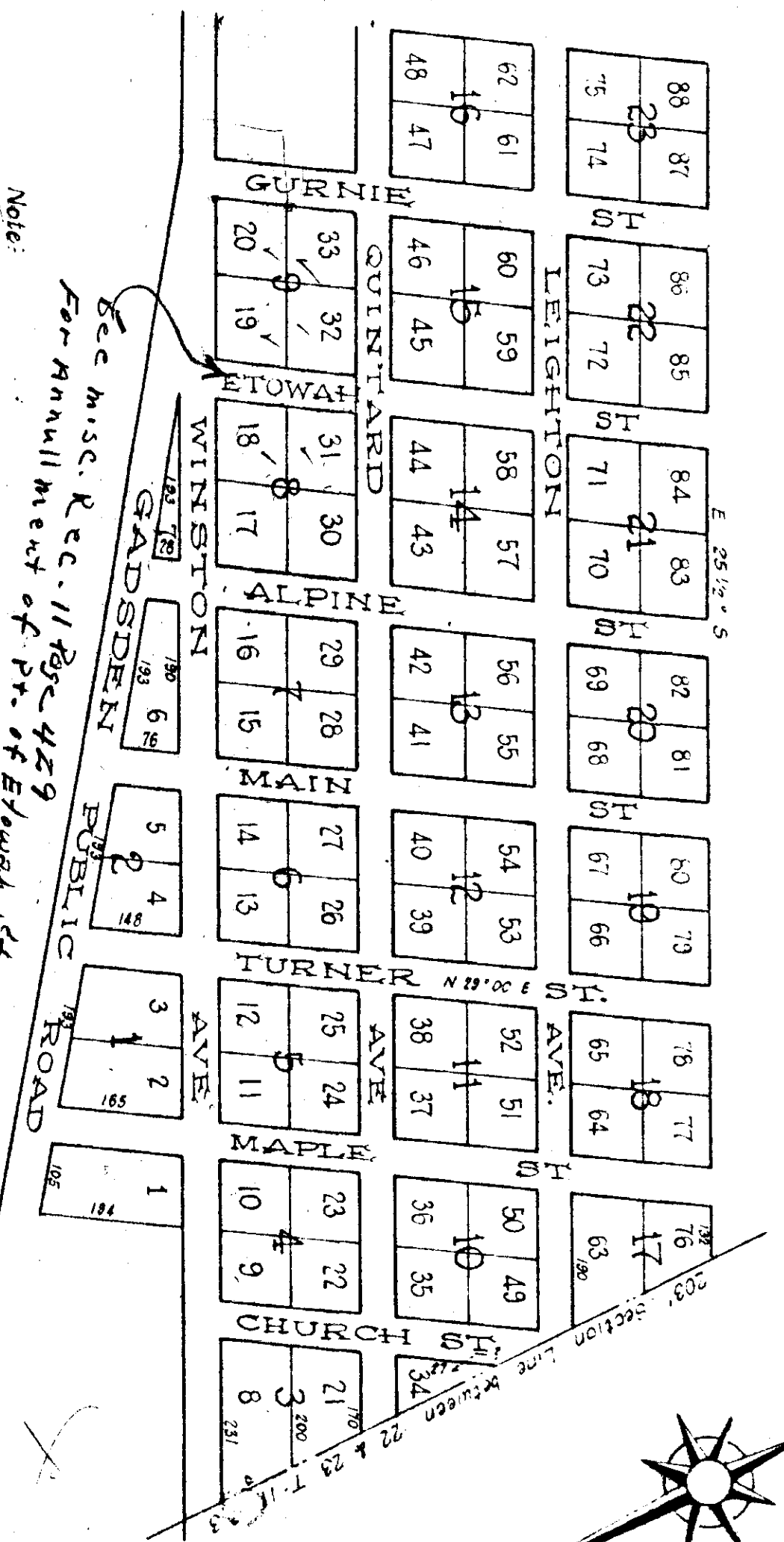


P. C. TURNER PLAT
