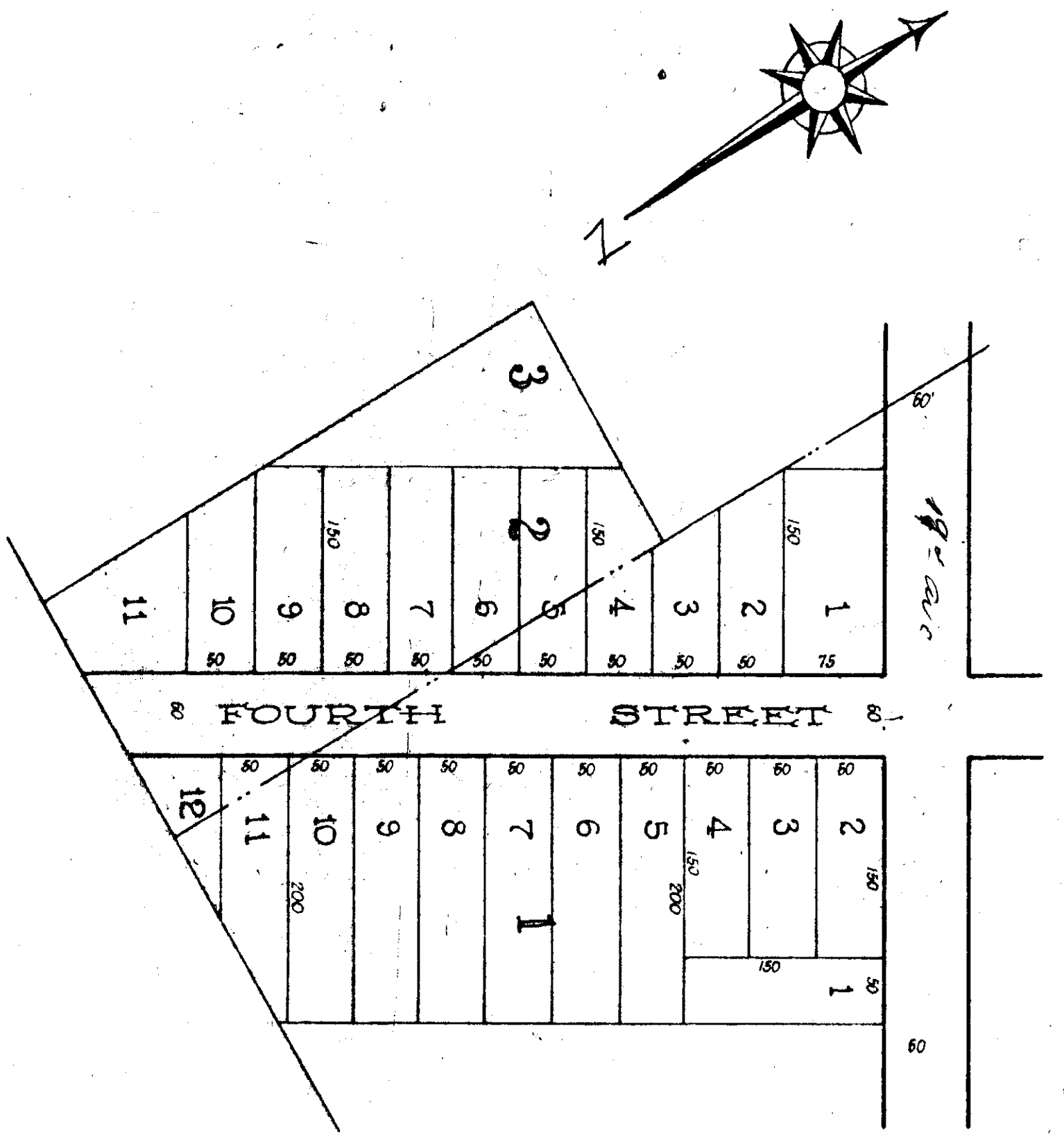


FENN ADDITION
