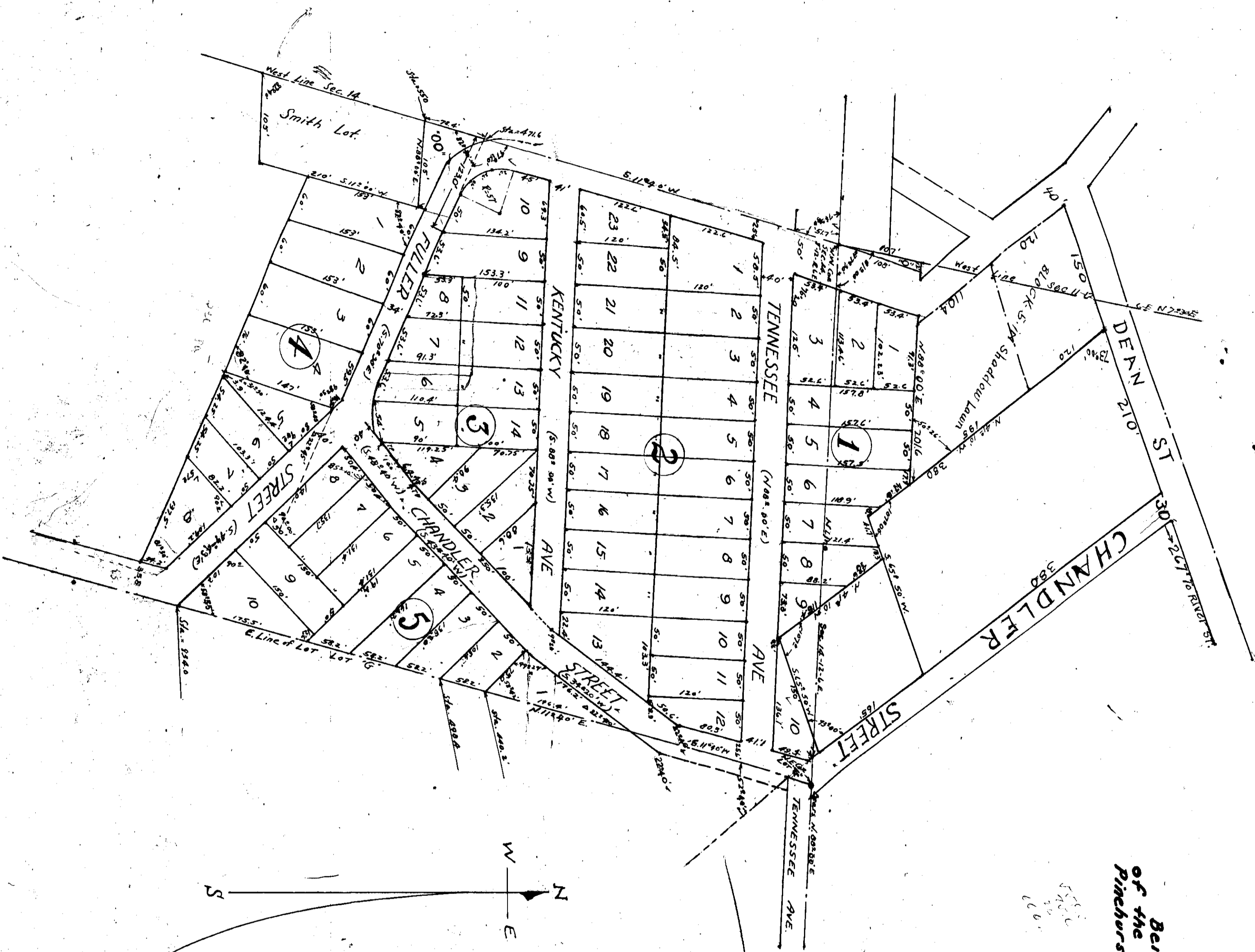


# COLLEGE HEIGHTS
